On May 20, 2009, Darsie Alexander, Chief Curator at the Walker Art Center; Dennis Jon, Associate Curator of Prints and Drawings at the Minneapolis Institute of Arts and Diane Mullin, Associate Curator at the Weisman Art Museum looked at prints from 63 local artists. 51 of their prints were selected for a show in Highpoint's spacious new gallery at 912 Lake Street West.
